

Fundraisers Agreement

**Memorandum of Understanding

1. The Donations

2 Purpose of the Donations

We fund and promote research that leads to new understanding and treatments, and brings us closer to a cure for MND.

We campaign and raise awareness so the needs of people with MND and everyone who cares for them are recognised and addressed by wider society.

3. Restrictions

The Association undertakes that the donations listed in **Schedule A** will, unless prior written consent is obtained from the Donor, be used for unrestricted funding of the Association

4. Publicity

The Donor’s name will only be publicised if the Donor approves, and the wording of any external press releases or publicity will be approved by the Donor in advance.
